ORDINANCE NO. 2020 - 16**

**ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 120 (FIREARMS) OF THE REVISED
GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF BUTLER**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Butler, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 120 of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Butler entitled "Firearms," shall be amended by the following amendments to Section 120-2 which shall read as follows:

Chapter 120-2 Definitions.

FIREARMS – Includes air guns, air pistols, spring guns or pistols, shotguns, rifles, pistols, revolvers, automatic pistols and/or any handgun of any caliber and weapons capable of launching projectiles such as bows and arrows, compound bows, crossbows and ballistic slingshots within Borough limits.

Section 2. If any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid in any Court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the other sections or provisions of this Ordinance, except so far as the section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

Section 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage and publication in the manner provided by law.
