REPORTS OF COMMITTEES AND DEPARTMENT HEADS

Council President Verdonik reported that he spoke with the CFO and all departments are doing a tremendous job staying within budget. The EDC has 1 remaining concert in the park on August 26th. He reported that there was no recreation meeting in August but Summer Rec has been going really well and Stonybrook has been well attended this summer- more than previous years.

Councilman Fox reported that the work on Pearl, Mabey, and Hasbrouck is nearing completion with just the new signs and pavement markings needed. The Borough experienced a watermain break underneath the newly paid surface of the project so needed to repair that and re-pave. DPW is meeting with Tilcon to review paving schedule. Jim Lampmann said we benefit from the delayed start-date of mid-late September because the price of asphalt went down appx \$9/ton. DPW has been in contact with the Butler BPD regarding increased pedestrian safety at the corners of Park Pl., Kiel Ave., & Main St. Butler maintained crosswalks are in good condition and a request was made to Morris County to address the ones on their roads.

Councilman Regis reported National Night Out went well with combined efforts of BPD and the electric department. In July, there were 15 motor vehicle accidents – 6 considered reportable with 5 injuries. There were 4 DWI's and 3 arrests. There is no Fire Report.

Councilman Meier reported in the Electric Dept., both substations were treated with weed control, by-pass switches were locked off in anticipation of heavy load in the hot weather and new poles have been received. He reported a summary of all new services, repairs, upgrades, service relocations and maintenance in our service areas for the month. All meters were read and reported for the month. All delinquencies, outage calls and customer complaints both residential and commercial were handled and resolved. He reported that the Museum hosted its August meeting with 14 people in attendance. RBS & ADS Yearbooks have arrived at the museum. Class of 1972 reunion is in the works for October 8th.

Councilman Piccirillo reported that the Health Dept. did not have a meeting this month so there is report.

NEW/UNFINISHED BUSINESS

- Carry/Conceal Gun Legislation- Chief Chimento submitted a memo suggesting limitations regarding the new carry/conceal gun legislation and inquired whether we are enacting any limits on the areas where someone can carry a gun. The Mayor strongly disagreed with enforcing "Gun Free Zones" anywhere in this town and said he will not sign anything supporting that. Council had varying opinions. Mr. Lampmann suggested putting limitations such as recreational facilities like Stony Brook where when entering the water, the gun could possibly be left unattended and in the reach of a child. In favor of drafting limitations are Verdonik and Fox. Not in favor are: Meier, Piccirillo and Regis. Mr. Lampmann will inform the Chief.
- Approval of new Firefighter application - Salvatore Ciccone. Council unanimously approved the application.
- Butler United Methodist use of Butler Park – Use permitted with picnic food as long as they are responsible for full clean-up with their own trash bags and receptacles. No food/trash bags left in the park.
- Brandi Greco asked for confirmation of the Council's attendance for the 9-11 Memorial Walk from Butler to Bloomingdale.
- Gartage Contract Renewal- Mr. Lampmann prepared specs for the renewal with both single stream and co-mingled options. Another option not included is that the Borough be responsible for the marketing of recyclables but that would be a risk as it is difficult to budget. We will advertise this weekend for bid in October and award in November.

The Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized and directed to do all other matters necessary, useful, convenient or desirable to accomplish the delivery of the notes to the purchasers thereof as promptly as possible, including (i) the preparation, execution and dissemination of a Preliminary Official Statement and Final Official Statement with respect to the notes, (ii) preparation, distribution and publication, if necessary, of a Notice of Sale with respect to the notes, (iii) execution of a Continuing Disclosure Undertaking, with respect to the notes in accordance with Rule 15c2 12 promulgated by the Securities and Exchange Commission and (iv) execution of an arbitrage and use of proceeds certificate certifying that, among other things, the Borough, to the extent it is empowered and allowed under applicable law, will do and perform all acts and things necessary or desirable to assure that interest paid on the notes is not included in gross income under Section 103 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.

Section 28. All action heretofore taken by Borough officials and professionals with regard to the sale and award of the notes is hereby ratified, confirmed, adopted and approved.

Section 29. This resolution shall take effect immediately.



RESOLUTION 2022-74
RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF BUTLER
OPPOSING THE PROPOSED RATE INCREASES TO THE STATE HEALTH BENEFITS PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the State Health Benefits Program (SHBP), governed by N.J.S.A. 52:14-17.25 et seq., offers medical, prescription drug, and dental coverage to qualified state and participating local government public employees, retirees, and eligible dependents; and

WHEREAS, all SHBP plans are self-funded meaning that the money paid out for benefits comes directly from a SHBP account funded by the state, participating local employers, and member premiums; and

WHEREAS, the Division of Pensions and Benefits is responsible for the daily administrative activities of the SHBP, and the State Health Benefits Commission is the executive organization responsible for overseeing the SHBP; and

WHEREAS, the State Health Benefits Commission, comprised of state officials and union representatives, annually considers the calendar year premium levels for the Local Government Employer Group of the SHBP based on recommendations found in the Rate Setting Recommendation Analysis of the Local Government Employee Group; and

WHEREAS, the proposed rate increases for the 2023 Local Government Employer Group included a 24% increase for Active Medical, a 3.7% increase for Active Pharmacy, a 15.6% increase in Early Retiree Medical, and a 0.7% increase for Medicare. Early Retiree Pharmacy has a 5.7% decrease; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Treasury has reported that rates for active members and early retirees would likely be increased between 12% - 20% across the various plans for the upcoming year; and

WHEREAS, such proposed exorbitant rate increases will fall upon the local property taxpayer along with the local public employees at a time where there is record inflation; and

WHEREAS, the proposed premium increase for most active employees will take thousands more out of their paychecks annually and lead to huge costs for local governments that will translate into higher property tax bills for struggling families; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Butler in the County of Morris does call upon the State Health Benefit Commission to reject the proposed rate increase; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Butler in the County of Morris urges the legislature to adopt legislation establishing an investigative committee with subpoena power to investigate the provenance of the proposed SHBP rate increases and delay the vote on any change to the rate for the 2023 Local Government Employer Group until a full investigation has been concluded; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Butler in the County of Morris urges the legislature to adopt legislation expanding the composition of the State Health Benefits Commission to include representatives from both municipal and county governments; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Butler in the County of Morris does further urge the legislature to investigate allegations published by Bloomberg that the Murphy administration squashed an attempt to recover \$34 million which was paid to Horizon for a failed program to lower insurance costs, further injuring the municipal taxpayers; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to Governor Murphy, State Treasurer Elizabeth Muoio, Senate President Nick Scutari, Assembly Speaker Craig Coughlin, Senator Joseph Pennacchio, Assemblyman Jay Weber, Assemblyman Christian Barranco, and the New Jersey State League of Municipalities.




