#### **REPORTS OF COMMITTEES AND DEPARTMENT HEADS**

<u>Council President Verdonik</u> reported that there are 2 remaining EDC sponsored Concerts in the Park on the last Friday of July and August. He announced that the EDC will be selling Christmas Ornaments this year with more information forthcoming. He reported that Stonybrook attendance has been high and they will be holding a comhole tournament on July 23<sup>rd</sup>. He reported that after speaking with CFO, Jim Kozimor and although inflation is at 9% our departments heads are all staying on budget at this time.

<u>Councilman Fox</u> reported that work is underway on the Pearl, Mabey, Hasbrouck project with an anticipated completion date of Friday, July 22. We are waiting on Tilcon for a start date on milling and paving of Cleary, Sanders, Orchard, Tintle, Smith, Stony Hill Ct and Laurel with the hopes it will be completed before school resumes. DPW crews came in at 5am and performed a clean sweep on Main St on July 8th including weeding and cleaning of existing trash cans with the exception of River Place which is private property. This will continue throughout the summer to see if it helps.

<u>Councilman Regis</u> reported 23 motor vehicle accidents for the month of June resulting in 2 injuries. There was 1 DUI arrest, 3 arrests for a variety of criminal offenses and 115 summonses issued.

<u>Councilman Calvi</u> reported that the South Gifford water project is progressing well. The water main is installed and work will now focus on services to each individual residence. Once those are done, water will be pressure tested and bacteria tested before switching over and abandoning the old lines. Completion expected in early August. Sewer pump station was cleaned and checked with no issues, meters were read and water billed for month of July.

<u>Councilman Meier</u> reported in the Electric Dept., safety demonstrations and classroom presentations have resumed in the Butler School District. Crews assisted Kinnelon Fire Dept with a smoke condition in the Pearl Miller School electrical room. He reported a summary of all new services, repairs, upgrades, service relocations and maintenance in our service areas for the month including 3 compromised poles being replaced at Star Lake Camp. All meters were read and reported for the month. All delinquencies, outage calls and customer complaints both residential and commercial were handled and resolved.

He reported that the Museum will be hosting 2 Cemetery Walking Tours on 10/15 - 1 daytime and 1 evening. The Museum took part in Morris County's Pathways to History program in May and drew a large crowd to museum. In June, the 5<sup>th</sup> graders visited as part of a walking field trip. The museum will be purchasing and installing 2 boards to display outside to alert when they are open. Updates to the website and social media accounts are bringing in more people.

Councilman Piccirillo reported that he did not attend last months' Health Dept meeting so has nothing to report.

# AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND REVISING CHAPTER 225, "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC", OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES AND ADDING BUTLER PLAZA TO THE LIST OF PROPERTIES WHERE THE OWNER HAS REQUESTED TITLE 39 TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT

WHEREAS, Butler Plaza Partnership LLC, the owner of Butler Plaza, has filed a written consent with the Borough of Butler that the provisions of Subtitle One, Title 39 of the revised Statutes of New Jersey be made applicable to the semi-public roads, streets, driveways and parking lots in the Butler Plaza shopping center located in the Borough of Butler, County of Morris; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Engineer and the Chief of Police have reviewed the request and the proposed traffic plans and have recommended that the Governing Body approve the application for Title 39 traffic enforcement.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED,** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Butler, in the County of Morris, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

**Section 1.** Chapter 225 of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Butler, Section 225-37, "Application of Title 39 to Private Property", be amended by the inclusion of new subsection E. which shall read, in its entirety, as follows:

E. Butler Plaza Traffic regulations applicable to Butler Plaza are as shown on the Striping and Signage Plan based on an as-built survey prepared by Marsh Associates, Inc. dated 12/2/21, last revised 3/17/22.

**Section 2.** Chapter 225 of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Butler, Section 225-58, "Schedule XXI: Regulation of Private Property", shall be amended to read, in its entirety, as follows:

## § 225-58. Schedule XXI: Regulation of Private Property.

In accordance with the provisions of § 225-37 and pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:5A-1, Subtitle 1 of Title 39 of the New Jersey Statutes shall apply to the following private properties:

Section 3. This Ordinance may be renumbered for codification purposes.

**Section 4**. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**Section 5**. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage and publication in the manner provided by law.
