The Council Meeting of the Butler Mayor and Council was opened by Mayor Alviene who indicated that the meeting was being held in compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act having been duly advertised and posted in Borough Hall. This was followed by the Pledge to the Flag and a Moment of Reflection.

### **ROLL CALL**

Recognition of William Sulski for his service on the Borough of Butler Planning Board Mayor Alviene remarked that this is the best part of the meeting when we show our appreciation to a resident for their years of service to the community; he also wanted to thank the members of the Butler Planning Board in attendance. Mayor Alviene presented Mr. Sulski with a plaque commemorating his years of service from 1998 through 2013; he noted that his presence would be missed on the board. Mr. Sulski wanted to thank the members of the Board, Karen Becker,

the Board Attorney, and Engineer that he has worked with over the years.

## MEETING OF PUBLIC AND INVITATION FOR DISCUSSION

Mayor Alviene opened the meeting to the public at this time.

Ken Montanye, 8 Northwestern Avenue informed the Mayor and Council that Butler Dollar Plus at 228 Main Street has reopened with a new owner, who will be stocking the store with new merchandise. Mr. Montanye wanted to thank Jim Lampmann for the snow removal on Main Street done by the Department of Public Works, noting it opens up parking spaces for the public to shop at the downtown stores; and for dealing with the issue of people dumping snow into the street or onto any public property. He asked that perhaps residents could adopt the fire hydrant in front of their home and remove the snow around them for easy access by the fire department.

Mr. Montanye noted that he takes his appointment to the Museum Committee very seriously, and will report any issues he sees to the Mayor and Council. He would like to report that following the latest snowstorm snow was plowed up against the Museum and the handicapped railing was broken, he feels that with all the funds expended more care should be taken when plowing. Mr.

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Lampmann responded that the Borough would go in and remove the snow from the building; however, the Borough is not the only entity that plows that parking lot. Regarding the damage to the railing, the Borough does not know who caused it but it will be repaired. Mayor Alviene and Mr. Lampmann noted that additional snow clearing would be done in the parking lot prior to the scheduled March 5, meeting at the Museum.

Mr. Montanye prefaced his comments regarding the handicapped ramp that this is his opinion and the comments are not on behalf of the museum committee. He expressed his dislike for the handicapped ramp at the museum; he feels that there is an obvious design flaw with the ramp. Mr. Oostdyk noted that we could not make the changes to the ramp without the architect approval. Mayor Alviene suggested that we forward his written comments to the architects for their response.

Ingrid Vida, 17 Excelsior Place and Will and Victoria Manga 15 Excelsior Place are present this evening to inform the Mayor and Council that they are having issues with "rust" water at their homes. Mr. Manga noted the Borough has provided a partial solution, which has lessened the problem but not completely alleviating it. Mr. Lampmann noted that the Water Engineer suggested that flushing be done on a regular basis, the Borough has been doing this consistently, however, he was not aware that the problem continued or had exacerbated, as this is the first time he has heard from any of the residents since 2009. Mr. Lampmann explained that the Borough is not sure where the water service is connected at either the water main or a hydrant stub. Mr. Lampmann will contact Bill Ryden the Borough Water Engineer to reevaluate the situation. Councilman Verdonik and Mayor Alviene explained that the issue will be addressed however, it will take time. Mr. Manga explained that as a taxpayer he is frustrated, he would like this problem resolved completely. Mayor Alviene asked that Mr. Manga remain in contact with the Borough about the status of his water quality.

Seeing no one else come forward to speak Councilman Fox made a motion to close this public portion of the meeting, seconded by Councilman McNear.

All in favor.

### REPORTS OF COMMITTEES AND DEPARTMENT HEADS:

<u>Council President Vath</u> noted that Mr. Lampmann has prepared a tentative schedule for 2014 Budget Meetings; he will hand out copies and ask that everyone review the dates so meetings can be arranged.

<u>Councilman Fox</u> reporting on roads that this has been a very bad winter, approximately 50 inches of snow in two months is horrendous; men are working very long hours. More money has been expended for snow removal in the last six weeks then all of last winter.

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<u>Councilman Regis</u> reporting on the Police Department nominations to the 2013 Morris County 200 Club, Lieutenant Michael Moeller, Officers Jorge Reyes and George Beyloune, along with several Kinnelon Police officers and members of the Morris County Prosecutors Office. The nomination is for an incident in July 2013 where a juvenile contemplating suicide threatened to jump off the Route 23 Maple Lake Road overpass. The result of the collaboration between all departments involved was the safe removal and treatment of the young man. Sergeant Keith Soules and Officer Dimitri Clarke received commendations from Kinnelon for their assistance in a life saving effort while working in conjunction with the Kinnelon Police.

<u>Councilman Verdonik</u> noted that water was quiet, however, after hearing from the residents of Excelsior Place he will do everything he can to resolve their issue as expediently as possible.

<u>Councilman Meier</u> reporting that the winter of 2014 has been a challenge with the snow and subzero temperatures we have experienced. Although there has been a change in staff, the newer employees are working out very well. Tree trimming is ongoing, workers completed the installation of an above ground temporary conduit on South Glen Road, providing temporary power to the residents until the ground thaws so the underground service can be reinstalled. Snow removal took place at the substation to allow access to the switchgear in case of emergency. All meters were read and recorded; any delinquent accounts were addressed along with any customer complaints.

<u>Councilman McNear</u> reported that the Board of Health meeting scheduled for January 22, 2014 was cancelled due to weather conditions; he will attend the February 26, meeting and provide a report at the March 18, 2014 Regular Council Meeting.

Currently the pipe coming from High Street has a slight point upstream, normally this would not be an issue, however, during times of heavy flow, and the current pipe diverts the flow back into the pipe with the backflow coming out in the Butler Police station. They would like to install new piping which would eliminate the backflow issue. The PRBRSA requires Borough permission to go over the pipe on High Street; the new pipe will belong to them, and a temporary easement is required for installation of the new piping, while eliminating the old section. Funding for the entire project is by the PRBRSA.

### INVITATION FOR DISCUSSION FROM THE PUBLIC:

Mayor Alviene opened this portion of the meeting to the public to speak.

Alan Bird, 43 Rafkind Road, Bloomingdale wanted to thank the Mayor and Borough Council for their support of the museum; the members are trying to get it up and running. He would also like to thank Jim Lampmann for his support as he has worked with the various issues that have arisen with the museum. Mr. Bird noted that the museum committee would like to add members to replace the "inactive" ones, perhaps the ordinance could be changed to add members or removal of inactive members and bringing on some younger members who are more computer literate and able to perform physical tasks. Regarding the handicapped access ramp, he would like to see if a more practical railing can be designed and installed while remaining ADA compliant, currently the ramp must be maneuvered in order to access the museum. The rear of the building is not feasible as this is adjacent to the active railroad tracks. Mr. Bird would like to have the inactive members either removed or perhaps become Associate members.

Mayor Alviene explained that the Borough will forward the concerns onto the architect and when we receive their response this will determine how we will proceed, however, if the ramp is required to remain as is then everyone must accept this and move on.

Councilman Regis enquired as to how many new members are interested and how many inactive members are on the committee.

Mr. Lampmann explained that the amount of members of a committee determines the number of attendees required for a quorum, which could lead to voting problems in the future.

<u>Ken Montanye</u>, 8 North Western Avenue informed the Mayor and Council that the ordinance calls for 11 members. He wanted to thank the Mayor and Council for painting and the fact that the work is being by our DPW, which is cost effective. Mr. Montanye stated that he wants to get the museum open as soon as possible.

Councilman Fox seeing no one else come forward to speak closed this public portion of the meeting.

Moved: Fox Second: McNear

All in favor.

Mr. Lampmann wanted to recommend Jeff Ricker for the Line Superintendent in the Electric Utility. The Council agreed with the choice, Mr. Lampmann to begin negotiations.

Motion to go into closed session.

Moved: Vath Second: Meier

All in favor.

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Second: Regis

Motion to return to open session. Moved: Fox All in favor.

Mr. Lampmann informed the Mayor and Council that he has been actively seeking an Information Technology Professional, with the retirement of Chief Card there is a void at the Police Department for maintenance of their computer equipment. Although hiring an outside firm might seem feasible, most do not operate on a 24-hour basis, usually they are available during business hours, which could adversely affect the Police Department. Mr. Lampmann explained that he had a candidate, who would have taken the position for approximately \$100,000 yearly, while this is a large expenditure, he approached other nearby municipalities about entering into a shared services agreement, and several were amenable to this, unfortunately, that individual has accepted a position elsewhere, paying considerably more money. The shared services agreements would offset a portion of the cost to the Borough, also the Butler Board of Education will use the services at a lower rate than is currently paid to the consultants they currently hire. He noted that the former Chief of Police Edward Card would be a good candidate as he has extensive experience with the computer systems currently in use by the Police Department. Although he has a basic knowledge of the systems used at Borough Hall; he does not know all the software currently in use at Borough Hall, he possesses many of the required licenses for our systems. Councilman Fox noted that Mr. Lampmann is working a tremendous amount of hours trying to maintain all the computer equipment. He is currently doing the work of a superintendent of an electric company, running the water department, maintaining two, three, or four other towns in the mean time, while still trying to conduct the town's business and maintaining the Borough's computers 24/7, dealing with resident complaints, it does not stop. Councilman Fox feels that this issue needs pursuing, noting that corporations today all have "IT" personnel, it is a real need today, as you need a dedicated employee. Councilman Fox noted he does not want Acting Chief Chimento to feel that former Chief Card will be working in a supervisory capacity in the Police Department. A decision needs to be made now, Mayor Alviene noted; Mr. Lampmann requires help, as this is a benefit to the Borough. The salary Mr. Lampmann spoke of is below the asking price of an "IT" specialist in corporate America.

Mr. Lampmann has already spoken to Acting Chief Chimento, who has no issue with bringing in Edward Card as the "IT" specialist; Mr. Lampmann has also contacted the New Jersey Pension system for clarification about the legality of hiring Edward Card for this position. Mr. Lampmann informed the Mayor and Council that Mr. Card has owned and operated an "IT" Company for years and that is the scope of his current job as "IT" director for 37 schools in the Archdiocese of Paterson. The upside of hiring Mr. Card is there is no pension or health benefit requirement as he is not eligible to participate in either, additionally, he is an expert as far as the police radios, and mobile computers are concerned. The monies available for the salary can come from many areas. Councilman McNear agrees that an "IT" person needs to be hired, however, he is not sold on Ed Card, he is not aware of his "IT" expertise, perhaps this would be an opportunity to take a look at who is out there at this time. Councilman Fox noted that there are many positives to hiring Ed Card for this position, he already knows the system, there is no

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learning curve, and the Administrator can just hand off the duties to him. Mayor Alviene reiterated Councilman Fox reasons for hiring Ed Card as this a win win situation for the Borough. Mr. Lampmann does not have the required licenses to maintain the hardware and or software, if he does the work he voids the warranty, it would not be fiscally responsible for him to pursue the licensing. The majority of the Council was in agreement with the decision to pursue Ed Card for the position of "IT" specialist.

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# Borough of Butler Resolution No. 2014-27 Resolution Calling on the Legislature to Permanently Adopt the 2% Cap on Interest Arbitration Awards

**WHEREAS**, on December 21, 2010, Governor Christie signed into law reforms to the Arbitration process that took effect January 1, 2011; and

- **WHEREAS**, the reforms capped arbitration awards on economic factors to no more than 2%, provided for random selection of arbitrators, expedited the determination of awards, required the arbitrator to provide a written report detailing the weight accorded to each of the required considerations and expedited the appeal process; and
- **WHEREAS**, these reforms marked a dramatic change to the arbitration process and have helped municipalities to control the never-ending rise in public safety personnel costs; and
- **WHEREAS**, a key element of the reforms, capping arbitration awards on economic factors to no more than 2% of the property tax levy will expire on April 1, 2014; and
- WHEREAS, while municipalities are statutorily limited to raise their property tax levy by no more than 2%, with very limited exceptions, failure to extend the 2% cap on interest arbitration awards will force municipalities throughout the State to further reduce or even eliminate crucial services, personnel, and long-overdue infrastructure improvement projects in order to fund an arbitration award; and
- **WHEREAS**, the 2% Interest Arbitration cap has controlled one of the largest municipal expense, public safety salaries, not only through arbitration awards but through contract negotiations; and
- **WHEREAS**, absent further action by the Legislature, any contract that expires on or after April 1, 2014, will be subject to all new procedures and requirements, EXCEPT the 2% awards cap; and
- **WHEREAS**, without those limits, arbitrators will be able to impose awards that do not account for the 2% limit on the property tax levy, which would immediately threaten funding for all other municipal services; and
- **WHEREAS**, without the 2% cap on Interest Arbitration Awards but with the 2% cap on property tax levy local budget makers could be forced to reduce other essential municipal services to fund an arbitration award;
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the governing body of the Borough of Butler, County of Morris strongly urges the Legislature to permanently extend the 2% cap on interest arbitration awards prior to the April 1, 2014 sunset; and

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**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that a that a copy of this duly adopted resolution be forwarded to Senate President Stephen Sweeney, Assembly Speaker Vincent Prieto, Senator Joseph Pennacchio, Assemblywoman BettyLou DeCroce and Assemblyman Jay Webber, Governor Chris Christie, and the New Jersey State League of Municipalities.
