The Council Meeting of the Butler Mayor and Council was opened by Mayor Alviene who indicated that the meeting was being held in compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act having been duly advertised and posted in Borough Hall. This was followed by the Pledge to the Flag led by Boy Scouts from Butler and a Moment of Reflection

MEETING OF PUBLIC AND INVITATION FOR DISCUSSION

Bob Norman, 31 Cascade Way read that a bid was taken for trash and recycling removal, he asked if the Borough had looked into doing this in house, as the Borough is so successful with the Electric and Water Department. Mr. Lampmann explained he has researched the cost effectiveness of this, noting that other municipalities who provide this service the cost to them is far greater than the cost is greater for the Borough to provide self-pickup, then private pickup. There are many factors that influence the cost starting with hiring employees, purchase of garbage trucks and the cost of workers compensation insurance that must be carried, as solid waste removal has one of the highest accident rates.

<u>Margaret Spranzani, 32 Cleary Avenue</u> presented the Mayor and Council with a letter (attached) from the Butler Museum and Historical Committee thanking them and specifically acknowledging the assistance given to the Butler Museum by Jim Lampmann. His quick thinking in having the Borough employees move all the heaviest furniture to a room already carpeted allowed two rooms to have new carpet installed on two successive Saturdays.

Ken Montanye, 8 North Western Avenue wanted to request that the new signs be posted at the upper end of North Western Avenue, there is still one of the older signs at that location. In the past week, he had to turn back three deliveries for Western Avenue. He also requested replacement of the "Enter Only" sign previously knocked down at the entrance to the museum. He has one last request regarding the installation of a light in the parking lot in the rear of the Municipal Building near the clothing donation bins. He has concerns about safety in the area, as it is very dark.

COUNCIL MEETING NOVEMBER 3, 2014 7:00 PM 2

Mr. Lampmann explained that the Borough is in the process of replacing street signs, however, the new sign will probably not be ordered until Spring at the earliest. He is aware that there are several signs remaining that need replacement, however, they are costly, so the signs are being replaced in sections. Regarding the light installation in the rear parking lot by the clothing donation bins there are no electrical hookups near that location, several poles would be required to provide electrical service to that area, and the request will be reviewed as to feasibility and cost. Mr. Lampmann noted that the property in question might be leased to senior housing; he will review all the issues.

Seeing no one else come forward to speak Councilman Fox made a motion to close this public portion of the meeting, seconded by Councilman McNear. All in favor.

REPORTS OF COMMITTEES AND DEPARTMENT HEADS:

<u>Councilman McNear</u> reported that the Board of Health had a meeting on September 24, 2014. Child Health conferences were held on September 22, six registered, four attended. The Butler Health Department is offering a free vaccination program on November 24 for residents age 19 and over that are either uninsured or underinsured regarding vaccinations. Residents wishing to attend can schedule an appointment through the Rockaway Township Health Department at 973-983-2848.

<u>Councilman Meier</u> reporting on the Electric Utility, Utility Services removed all old electric meters remaining from the switchover to smart metering, they recycle all those meters and pay the Borough for them. Crews installed underground fault indicators where required, making locating the source of an outage much quicker. Tree trimming in Kinnelon continues, in Butler upgraded service was installed along with upgrades to service in Bloomingdale and West Milford. Riverdale was quiet, all meters were read and recorded, delinquent accounts were addressed.

<u>Councilman Verdonik</u> reporting on Water noting that flushing has been completed and the Water plant is operating on regular hours.

<u>Councilman Regis</u> reporting on the Police Department the three new officers are still in the academy, other officers are in various training courses, both mandatory and education for other responsibilities. The Butler Fire Department held their annual Halloween celebration; according to Chief Neill, it was a big success. Councilman Regis noted that the Fire Department does a tremendous job with this every year. As a reminder, this Saturday is the Butler Senior Holiday Dinner at the Firehouse.

COUNCIL MEETING NOVEMBER 3, 2014 7:00 PM 3

<u>Councilman Fox</u> reporting on Roads, basin and pothole repair continues; the Department of Public Works is trying to complete repairs prior to winter setting in. The salt shed was rebuilt over the summer to allow twice the storage capacity. All trucks have been winterized and any repairs needed were completed. We are awaiting the delivery of a new truck with a plow; it should arrive in approximately twelve weeks.

<u>Council President Vath</u> reporting on Finance noted that on the agenda, this evening is a resolution that cancels appropriation balances for the Public Employees Retirement System and the Police and Firemen's Retirement System, the billing was lower than anticipated. Those monies will be used to pay off an outstanding note of \$40,000 for a Special Assessment on Myrtle Avenue.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Amendments to Chapter 21 (Fire Department) of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Butler

Mr. Lampmann explained that he incorporated all the suggestions into this sample ordinance. Although this includes many ideas it does not include everything, this is a starting point for the amendments to the ordinance. Mayor Alviene noted that the initial plan was to have all the changes made and the ordinance in effect by the end of the year; however, at this point it is not possible with the remaining meetings left. Mr. Lampmann asked that the Mayor and Council forward any comments or suggestions to him prior to the December 2, 2014 meeting, so he may incorporate the changes prior to the meeting. Councilman Regis feels that it is easier for discussion to occur at a Workshop Meeting, as opposed to a Regular meeting.

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Authorizing the Provision of Employee Health Care Incentives

Mr. Lampmann noted that current IRS law allows up to \$6650.00 for a family or \$3350.00 for a single employee be placed into a Health Savings Account. As an incentive to switch from the "Cadillac Plans" to higher deductible plans, the Borough will match an employee's contribution up to \$3325.00 (family) or \$1675.00 (single). The reasoning for this is that beginning in 2018 there will be penalties for employees enrolled in "Cadillac Plans." While the employee would have a significant out of pocket expense, prior to insurance kicking in, the benefit would be a lower contribution for the premium for both the employee and the Borough. Mr. Lampmann asked for direction regarding the proper way to implement this would it be done by policy, ordinance or resolution. Councilman Fox noted this is the direction the Borough should take; the younger employees are generally healthier so the impact is not as great on them. The Mayor and Council concurred that this is a win-win situation for all. In response to question about employees, opting in and out of the program Mr. Lampmann explained that employees in the State Health benefits plan could only change coverage once a year unless there is a life-changing event, for example say an employee has coverage through their spouse and the spouse loses his or her job then you may enroll immediately. Councilman Regis wanted to express his gratitude to Mr. Lampmann and Mr. Kozimor for their hard work in looking for ways to save the Borough money. Mr. Woods explained that either policy or a resolution might be the way to go as far as notification requirements.

INVITATION FOR DISCUSSION FROM THE PUBLIC:

Mayor Alviene opened this portion of the meeting to the public to speak.

Bob Norman, 31 Cascade Way expressed his concern about a situation he recently observed, as he exited Cascade Way onto Route 23 South. A tractor-trailer delivering vehicles to the car dealership was in the middle of the highway, there was a person using a ladder to climb up on the trailer the ladder was in the roadway. He was going to contact the police however, he felt that by the time he contacted them they would have the vehicle backed into the lot. Mr. Norman suggested that perhaps they could hire a police officer for traffic control during the deliveries. Mayor Alviene noted that while that is a good suggestion it might not be as easy to implement. Mr. Lampmann explained that when making deliveries the driver waits for the light at Cascade Way to turn red, and then the driver backs the truck in to unload, rather than unloading vehicles on the shoulder of the road, it is impossible for the truck to pull in nose first and then turn around on that property. If the driver pulls in to the lot, they would have to back out onto the highway. Councilman Fox noted this might be an issue for the Planning Board depending on what is in the resolution.

Councilman Fox seeing no one else come forward to speak closed this public portion of the meeting. Moved: Fox Second: McNear All in favor.

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Councilman Regis wanted to note that Fire Department Chief Elections were held and Jim Neill was elected as Chief of the Fire Department.

§ 44-2. Appointment of members.

The Board of Recreation Commissioners shall consist of seven (7) persons appointed by the Mayor and up to two (2) alternate members appointed by the Mayor.

Section 2. If any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid in any Court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the other sections or provisions of this Ordinance, except so far as the section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

Section 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

URGING THE GOVERNOR AND LEGISLATURE TO RECOGNIZE AND PRESERVE THE STRENGTH OF LOCAL PENSION FUNDING WHEN CONSIDERING THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF GOVERNOR CHRISTIE'S PENSION AND HEALTH BENEFIT STUDY COMMISSION

WHEREAS, State actuaries confirm that the bipartisan pension and benefit reforms that were enacted in 2010 and 2011, coupled with the consistent pension payments made by responsible local governing bodies, are delivering the savings that had been promised by their advocates; and

WHEREAS, when analyzing the fiscal health of public employee pension and benefit systems, the experts make a distinction between local commitments for local employees and retirees, and the commitments that are the State government's responsibility; and

WHEREAS, according to the latest valuation reports, the local government Public Employees Retirement System (local PERS) and the local Police and Fire Retirement System (local PFRS) are actuarially sound, in large part due to the fact that municipalities and counties have made full employer contributions as required under the law for over a decade, with local PERS currently funded (comparing assets to liabilities) at 73.9% and local PFRS is currently funded at 76.9%, according to the experts; and

WHEREAS, the State PERS, on the other hand, is currently funded at 48.1%, and State PFRS is a little better, at 50.8%; and

WHEREAS, the Officers of the League of Municipalities have submitted a statement to Governor Christie's Pension and Health Benefit Study Commission, urging that the Final Report and Recommendations of that Study Commission not, in any way, weaken the vitality of the local pension plans; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the governing body of the Borough of Butler urges State policy-makers to recognize and protect the strength of the local PERS and local PFRS systems, and reject any recommendations that would threaten municipal budgets and property taxpayers; and be it, further,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that, while we recognize the State's budget problems and we are anxious to help in any way we can, we cannot help in any way that shifts new burdens to our property taxpayers and our dedicated public servants; and be it, finally,

RESOLVED, that certified copies of this Resolution be forwarded to Governor Chris Christie, State Treasurer Andrew Sidamon-Eristoff, our State Senator Joseph Pennacchio, our two representatives in the General Assembly Jay Webber and BettyLou DeCroce, and to the New Jersey League of Municipalities.
