MEETING OF PUBLIC AND INVITATION FOR DISCUSSION

Peggy Spranzani, 32 Cleary Avenue wanted to thank the Mayor and Council for their help, throughout the reconstruction of the Butler Museum. Ms. Spranzani presented the Mayor and Council with a letter (Attachment A) thanking them and listing concerns of the members of the Butler Museum and Historical Committee, many of the members are present this evening. She introduced those present, and extended an invitation to the Mayor, Borough Council and Administrator to come to the museum for a personal tour. Regarding the items on the list, she noted that Borough Employees have already addressed some items. Mayor Alviene noted that he is looking forward to the grand reopening in April, he will be happy to assist Ms. Spranzani with preparing the list of attendees for the event. Additionally, Ms. Spranzani noted that the museum is currently open on Saturdays from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

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REPORTS OF COMMITTEES AND DEPARTMENT HEADS:

<u>Councilman McNear</u> noted that an influenza clinic was held on October 22, 30 residents were vaccinated. There were two other health clinics scheduled for October; the first one was October 8, fourteen children were scheduled only four attended; the second one October 22, six children were scheduled and five attended. Additionally, November is National Diabetes month with a presentation scheduled for Wednesday, November 18, from 6:30 to 7:45 p.m., at Borough Hall, the topic being Diabetes Education and Support; call the Health Department to register.

<u>Councilman Meier</u>, reporting on Electric, Butler Power and Light noted that the 100th Anniversary of Butler Electric was a success. Crews have installed underground fault indicators in areas not previously equipped with them already, the devices save a considerable amount of time during primary cable ruptures. In Kinnelon, repairs and upgrades were completed, along with new service to the Kinnelon DPW building addition. Tree trimming continued in Butler, along with repairs and upgrades where required. Riverdale and West Milford were quiet, all meters were read and recorded, delinquent accounts were addressed.

Councilman Verdonik Water Department crews completed the flushing of the system on October 30. They are currently performing fire hydrant repairs, twelve required repair six are completed, work continues on the remaining six hydrants.

<u>Councilman Regis</u> reporting on the Butler Fire Department he noted that the Halloween party was a success with hundreds of children and adults attending. The Senior dinner went very well; the parking lot at the Butler Fire Department on Carey Avenue has been repaved and looks great. Regarding Police Department activities 246 summons were issued, our recently promoted Sergeant was in the top three in issuing summons. Officers are currently undergoing mandatory training in various areas.

<u>Councilman Fox</u> reported that the Borough is currently doing pothole repair on Maple Lake Road, it took several days to complete and residents have called to thank the Borough for the repairs. There has been work done at the light on Decker Road to remove the bump, making driving in the area much easier. Asphalt prices were lower this year resulting in monies remaining so an additional road may be paved this year, prior to the onset of winter.

<u>Council President Vath</u> reporting on Finance noted there is not much to report, he met with Jim Kozimor, CFO this afternoon, noting that there is a transfer resolution on the Agenda this evening. Budgets worksheets have been distributed to Department Heads meetings will be held in January 2016.

Mr. Lampmann noted that the Borough Hall generator installation has begun, it should take approximately two weeks.

ORDINANCE NO. 2015 - 16

ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 18 OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF BUTLER PERTAINING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Butler, County of

Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 18, Section 18-3 entitled "Composition", of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Butler shall be amended to read in its entirety as

follows:

§ 18-3. Composition.

The Economic Development Committee shall be comprised of seven (7) members and two (2) alternates to be appointed by the Borough Council. Two (2) members shall also be members of the Borough Council. Backup Licensed Operator Duties As of November 2, 2015

- Scheduling Shift Coverage
 - In the absence of the Licensed Operator of Record, the Backup Operator of Record shall be responsible for the scheduling of staff
- Responsible for Tracking Sick & Overtime in the absence of the Licensed Operator of Record (i.e. enter time in the system and signoff sick and overtime sheets)
- Aware of Projects being undertaken in the Plant
 - Be familiar with projects underway in the plant so as to be able to answer questions in the absence of the Licensed Operator of Record.
- Material Ordering/Inventory
 - In the absence of the Licensed Operator of Record, the Backup Operator of Record shall place orders for all NECESSARY supplies to keep the plant operating including treatment chemicals, lab supplies, etc.
- Safety
 - Responsible for employees using safety equipment.
 - Responsible for making sure equipment is worn on the jobsite and safety procedures are followed.
- Call-Outs
 - Responsible for taking all calls from dispatch in the absence of the Licensed Operator of Record.
 - Must be accessible 24/7 (unless prior arrangements are made with the Licensed Operator of Record) and shall carry a cell phone to take the emergency calls.
 - Time spent on the phone is not compensated
- Computer Knowledge
 - In the event of an extended absence of the Licensed Operator of Record, the Backup Operator of Record must be able to log in remotely to access and review the SCADA system when required. Remote login time will not be compensated.
 - Backup Operator of Record must be able to prepare and retrieve electronic data from the various computers/SCADA in the plant
 - Backup Operator of Record must be able to retrieve all data necessary to prepare DEP reports

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
