The school board is looking to out source the turf maintenance. That is for Hempstead Field and the practice field at a cost of approximately \$28,000. If they add Smith Field it would be \$35,000.

The Borough would get field time in exchange.

Mayor Heywang said we should protect the taxpayers investment also the recreation department has been using the fields for years.

Council feels a 50/50 split would be the best way to go. An Interlocal Agreement will be drawn up.

Second: Fox


