WHEREAS, Expired Robot, Bradley Hatfield, (hereinafter referred to as the "Applicant") have

made an Application to the Borough of Butler Planning Board (hereinafter referred to as the "Board"), for a

change in occupancy, to establish a comic book and collectible store, in 1,500 square feet at the existing

retail building known as 1477 Route 23; and

WHEREAS, the subject property is known as Block 54, Lot 1.08, as shown on the Tax Map of the

Borough of Butler, and is located at 1477 Route 23, in the Highway Business Zone; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was conducted on September 14, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Board has heard comments and testimony from the Applicant and with the public

having had the full opportunity to be heard; and

WHEREAS, a complete Application has been filed, the fees required by Borough Ordinance have

been paid, and it otherwise appears that the jurisdiction and powers of the Board have been properly invoked

and exercised.

NOW THEREFORE, the Planning Board makes the following findings of fact and conclusions of

law based upon the evidence presented at its public hearing, at which a record was made:

1. The Application before the Board involves a request for change in occupancy to allow the

establishment of a comic book and collectible store at the subject property.

2. The area of the proposed store is in excess of the minimum requirements.

3. The remaining 697 square feet may be added to any tenant or be used by the landlord as storage

or utilities. The space <u>may not</u> be rented independently, other than to a current tenant.

4. In that the proceedings in this matter were voice recorded, the recital of facts in this Resolution is

not intended to be all inclusive, but a summary and highlight of the complete record made before the Board.
